The Qatar Cultural Attache's visit to Canada from November 3, 2024 to November 6, 2024

The Qatar Cultural Attaché joined the Qatari delegation in attending the 85th International Education Conference, organized by the Canadian Bureau for International Education (CBIE) in Ottawa from November 3 to 6, 2024.

The delegation, led by Dr. Ibrahim bin Saleh Al-Naimi, Undersecretary of the Ministry of Education and Higher Education, also included senior officials and representatives from the Ministry of Education and Higher Education.



Dr. Al-Naimi highlighted the significance of student exchange programs and joint research projects in achieving global education goals in his address. He also stressed the need to preserve human and social capital through collaboration with international educational institutions, empowering youth for future leadership. Dr. Al-Naimi also highlighted Qatar's progress in digital education and AI, aligned with Qatar Vision 2030, and initiatives from the 2024–2030 strategy promoting modern learning and workforce readiness under the slogan "Igniting the Flame of Learning."



The Qatari delegation was supported by Qatar's ambassador to Canada, Dr. Khalid bin Rashid Al-Mansoori and The Qatar Cultural Attache' to USA and Canada Mr. Nasser Al-Naemi. The conference brought together over 1,300 participants from 50 countries, fostering discussions on innovation, international education, and its future role in promoting global understanding and sustainable partnerships.

The Qatari delegation, including representatives from the Ministry of Education and Higher Education, Qatar University, Education City, Doha University for Science and Technology, and the Qatari Cultural Attaché in the United States, participated in the conference organized by the Mexican Association of Universities (ANUIES) and the Mexican Association of International Education (AMPEI) in Tuxtla Gutiérrez, Mexico. The delegation highlighted Qatar's pioneering advancements in higher education, showcased its achievements, and explored opportunities for collaboration with universities across Latin America. The delegation also actively participated in engaging and productive panel discussions, further promoting Qatar's commitment to fostering international collaboration in higher education.

On the sidelines of the conference, members of the Ministry of Education and Higher Education, including Dr. Hareb Al-Jabri, Acting Assistant Undersecretary for Higher Education Affairs; Mr. Nasser Al Naemi, Cultural Attaché of Qatar to the United States and Canada; Mr. Hamad bin Khalid Al-Malek, Chargé d'Affaires at the Embassy of Qatar in Mexico; Mr. Mohammed bin Hamad Al Khalifa, Third Secretary of the Qatari Mission at the Embassy of Qatar in Mexico; and Dr. Nasser Al Emadi of Qatar University, held a significant meeting with the Mexican Minister of Education, H.E. Mario Delgado Carillo, Secretary of Public Education in Mexico. The meeting focused on strengthening bilateral cooperation in education and higher education.
