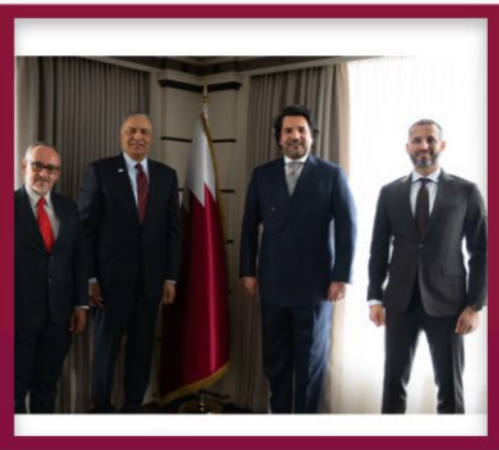


international conflict resolution. This collaboration underscores our commitment to nurturing the next generation of scholars and practitioners poised to shape global peacebuilding efforts.

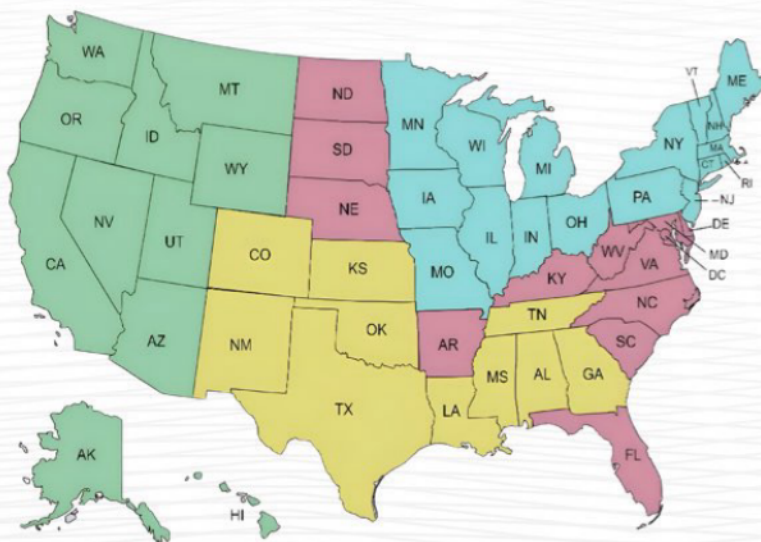
