Deadline: September 30, 2025

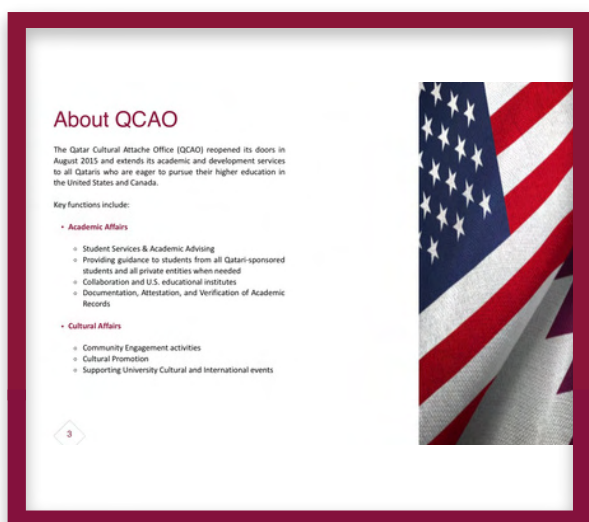

Stay tuned for our comprehensive Fall 2025 Virtual Orientation—an essential session for both new and continuing Qatari students in the U.S. The event will cover:

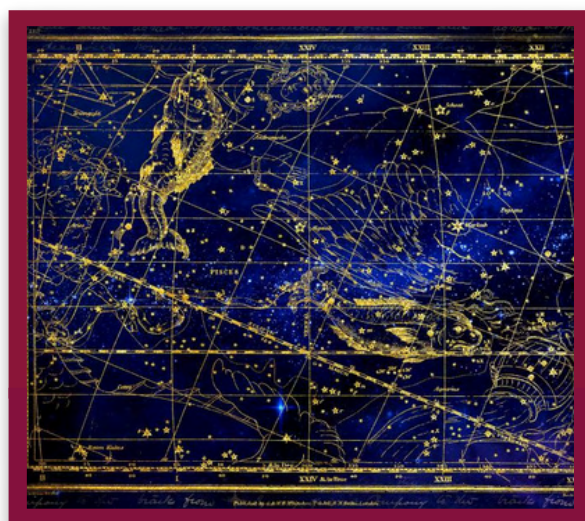

This unpaid internship is ideal for law students interested in privacy law, civil liberties, and federal regulatory policy. Interns assist with legal research, policy drafting, and reviewing interagency protocols related to civil rights protections.

Requires:

- Completion of one year of law school
- Strong writing and research skills
- Availability of 15–20 hours per week during the semester

- Qatari students and early-career professionals can also explore intensive short-term fellowships and professional certificates in investigative journalism, media ethics, and digital storytelling.

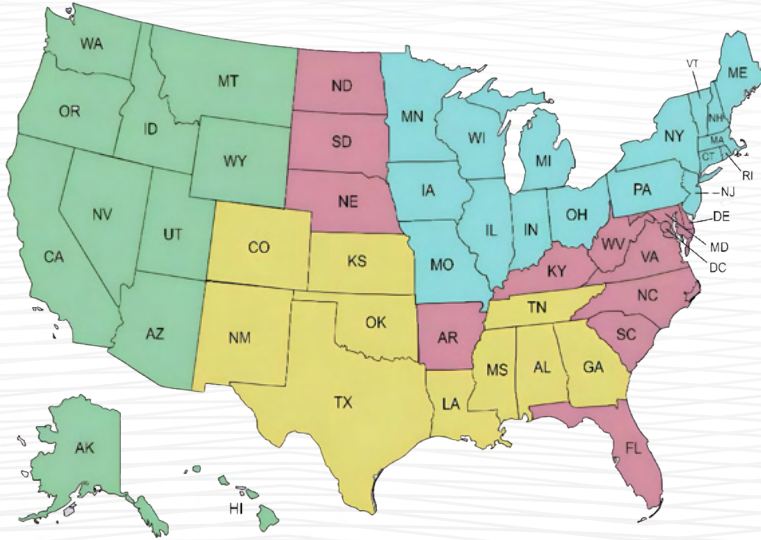
