Ministry of Education and Higher Education Delegation visit to the United States

In September 2025, a delegation from the Ministry of Education and Higher Education's Authentications Department conducted a strategic visit to the United States aimed at deepening Qatar's engagement with key higher education accrediting bodies. The mission included briefings and meetings at the U.S. Department of Education, the Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA), and George Mason University, complemented by a technical workshop at the Qatar Cultural Attaché Office in Washington, D.C. Each engagement offered critical insights into U.S. accreditation mechanisms, institutional governance, and academic evaluation standards. The visit is expected to inform future policy decisions, strengthen Qatar's degree recognition protocols, and enhance the Ministry's capacity to align national authentication processes with globally recognized benchmarks of academic integrity and quality assurance.

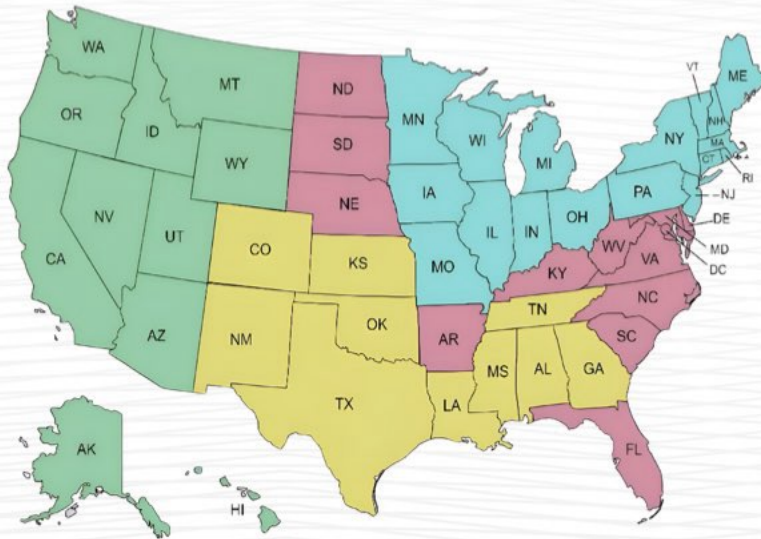
