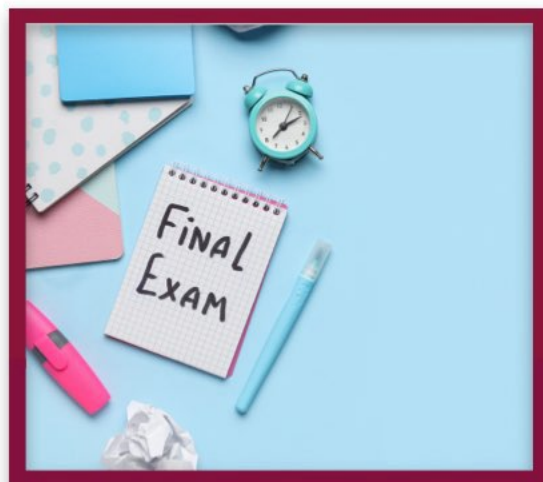
Qatar Cultural Attaché Office Meets with VUIM

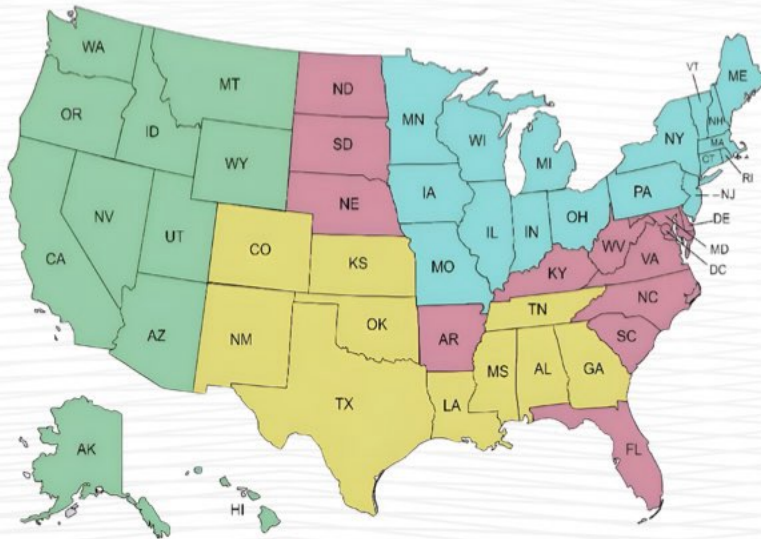
