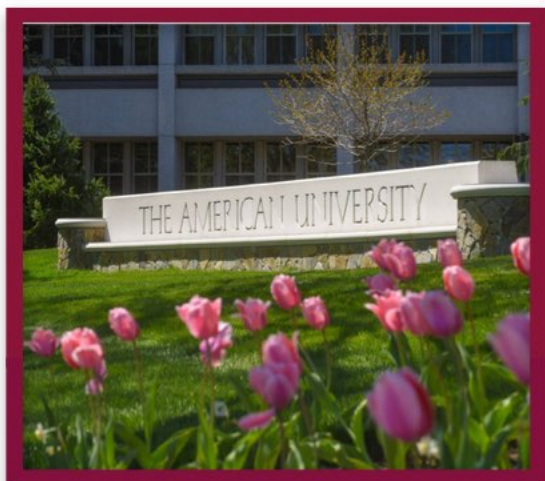


Pre-University Summer Programs in the USA

Located in Washington, D.C. at American University (AU), these include the “High School Summer Scholars” online model (rising sophomores to seniors, eligible with 3.0 GPA) and the “Community of Scholars” hybrid model (three-credit college-level course combining two weeks on-campus and one week online). Key features:

- High School Summer Scholars: one-credit asynchronous online courses, flexible scheduling.
- Community of Scholars: for rising juniors/seniors, three-credit hybrid course, on-campus Washington D.C. experience plus online component.
- Broad summer session logistics and credit-earning opportunities.

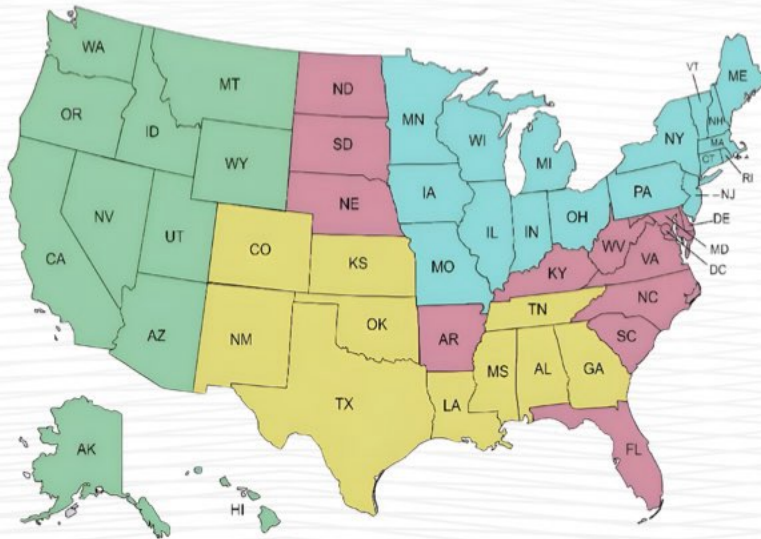
